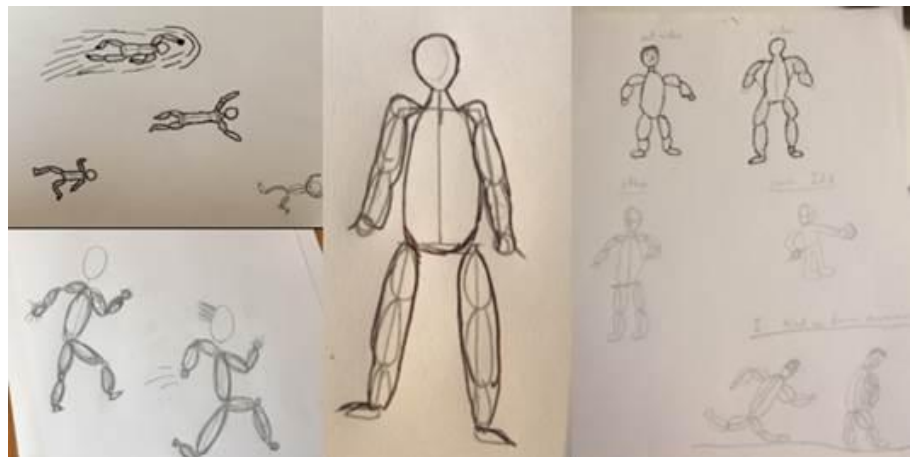
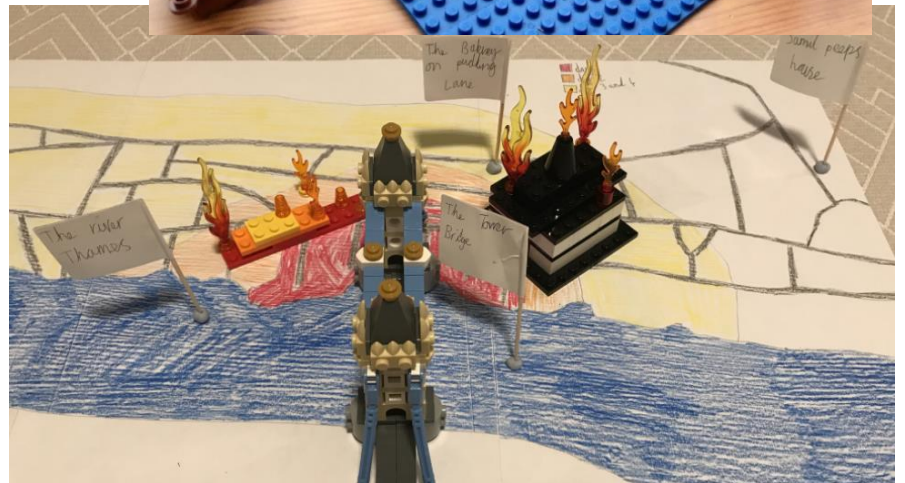
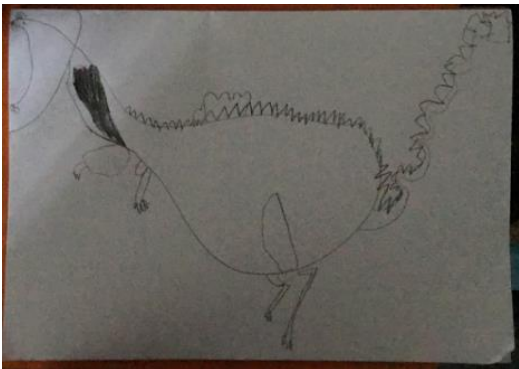
Some impressive examples of work from Seend School pupils during lockdown:
