

Seend Open Gardens—10th & 11th July 2021

1	Seend House	A Georgian house with 6 acres of gardens and paddocks. Framed with yew and box. Highlights include: cloud and rose garden, stream lavender, view of knot garden from above, fountain with grass border, walled garden as well as formal borders. Amazing view across the valley to Salisbury Plain. NB beware the vertical drop from the terrace.
2	The Dial House	A walled garden with herbaceous borders, gravel and box parterre and a loggia created from a pigsty.
3	The Former Vicarage	Sadly the garden has been left unattended for a few years prior to us purchasing the property in 2017. In 2019 we instructed Veronica Goodenough to work with us to design a new Contemporary style garden to compliment the house. We believe we have achieved this but will benefit from a few years of maturity. Only open on Sunday.
4	The Old Stables	The Old Stables is a walled garden dating from around 1800. The front garden was redesigned 10years ago. The rear has various borders, a small vegetable area and some water features.
5	The Manor	Large walled garden converted into a rococo garden with four quadrants based on different areas of the world - Italy, China, Africa and England. Also a folly ruin, and walled vegetable garden and orchard.
6	Garden Cottage	A peaceful, traditional cottage garden.
7	The Stable Yard	Restored Georgian stable yard of Seend Manor.
8	The Close	This attractive garden is work in progress, with a section of new woodland, mature trees, pots of herbs and flowers. The lawn is edged with lovely handwoven willow fencing.
9	30 The Lye	A small, simple garden with a wonderful display of potted plants and neat rows of vegetables.
10	8 Cooks Close	A small pretty garden with glorious views over to Bromham and Roundway. Part of the garden has a Japanese theme . A small corner is taken up with a Bali bed. There is also a studio as you enter the garden through the white door past the bay trees. Unfortunately there are steps which would prevent wheelchair access.
11	Fairholme	A small cottage garden.
12	Henmarsh Farm	Typical farmhouse garden, strong on fruit and vegetables. 7 minute walk down a leafy footpath.
13	Brow Cottage	A contemporary cottage garden created over the past 22 years and owned by a garden designer. It includes a potager, sunken pool, wildlife pond and well-stocked borders, as well as some new features since the opening in 2019.

C	Church of the Holy Cross	Beautiful 15 th century church, Flower Displays
