

Seend Open Gardens - 10th & 11th June 2023

1	Manor Cottage	One acre garden acting as a proscenium arch linking house and view.
2	Seend House	A Georgian house with 6 acres of gardens and paddocks. Framed with yew and box. Highlights include: cloud and rose garden, stream lavender, view of knot garden from above, fountain with grass border, walled garden as well as formal borders. Amazing view across the valley to Salisbury Plain. NB beware the vertical drop from the terrace.
3	The Dial House	A walled garden with herbaceous borders, gravel and box parterre and a loggia created from a pigsty.
4	The Old Stables	The Old Stables is a walled garden dating from around 1800. The front garden was redesigned 10 years ago. The rear has various borders, a small vegetable area and some water features.
5	The Manor	Large walled garden converted into a rococo garden with four quadrants based on different areas of the world - Italy, China, Africa and England. Also a folly ruin, and walled vegetable garden and orchard.
6	Garden Cottage	A peaceful, traditional cottage garden.
7	The Stable Yard	Restored Georgian stable yard of Seend Manor.
8	The Close	This attractive garden is work in progress, with a section of new woodland, mature trees, pots of herbs and flowers. The lawn is edged with lovely handwoven willow fencing.
9	30 The Lye	A small, simple garden with a wonderful display of potted plants and neat rows of vegetables.
10	Greenheys	A Traditional English walled cottage garden in former coaching Inn called The White Hart. Large herbaceous borders.
11	Fairholme	A small cottage garden.
12	Beech House	Plenty of balls amongst the plants! Small rose garden replanted last year. Walled kitchen garden. As everything is a month late there are still lots of peonies in bloom. Beech House Apple Juice 2022 for sale.
13	Henmarsh Farm	Typical farmhouse garden, strong on fruit and vegetables. Produce stall in aid of Mary of the Immaculate Conception. 7 minute walk down a leafy footpath from Seend High Street.
14	Inmarsh House	Mature garden with many shrubs and pond with rural views. Numerous small statues.
15	Brow Cottage	A contemporary cottage garden of contrasting spaces created over the past 24 years and owned by a garden designer. It includes well-stocked borders, plenty of seating, a sunken pool area, kitchen garden, wildflower lawn (which featured species bulbs in the Spring) and wildlife pond.
P	Irene Usher Memorial Pavilion	Refreshments: Cream Teas, Home made Cakes. Programmes for sale. LAST TEAS SERVED AT 5.30 PM. TOILETS.
C	Church of the Holy Cross	Beautiful 15th century church, Bellinging - Displays and information. See back page.
