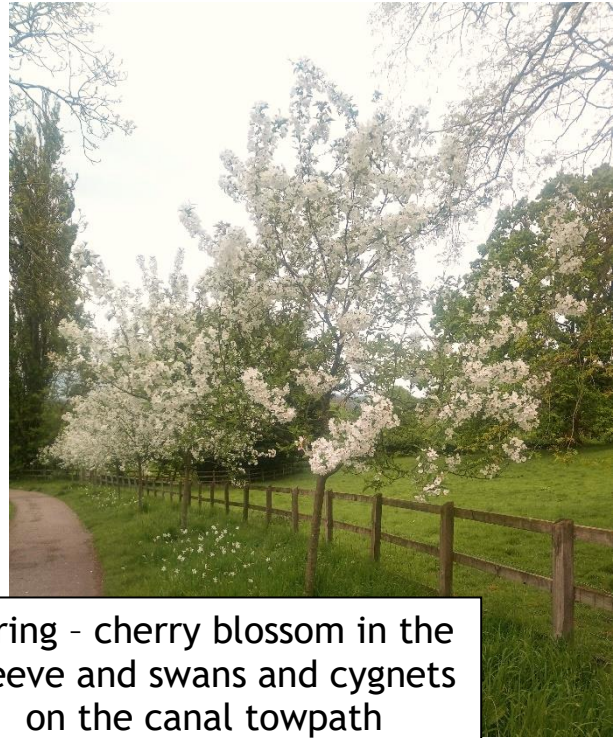
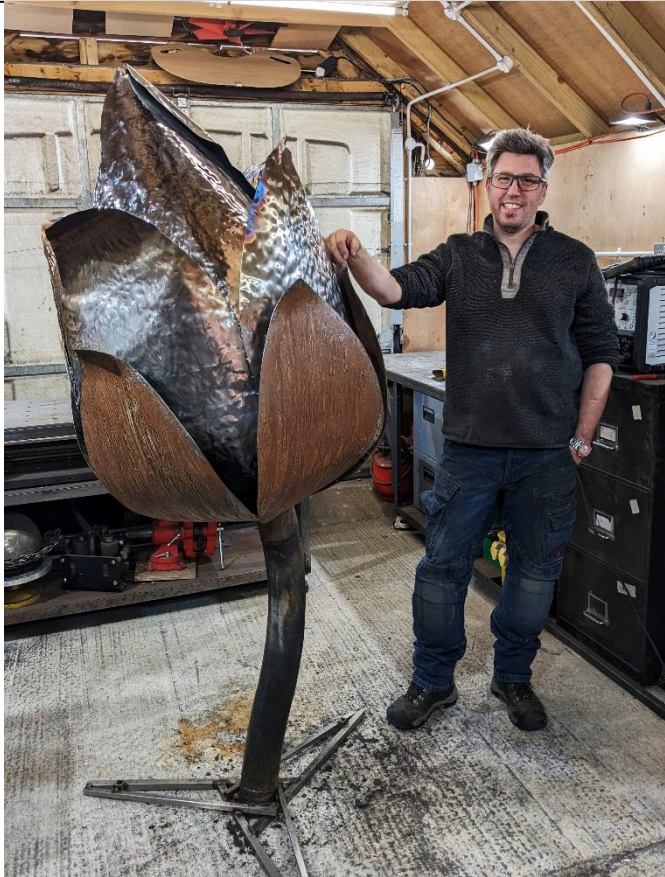
Possibly the first ever Hen Party at a Seend Beer Festival?
